RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION concerning

Holistic and Sustainable Solutions for Senior Citizens Task Force
For the purpose of establishing the Holistic and Sustainable Solutions for Senior Citizens Task
Force to assess and identify the fundamental needs of the senior citizen population in Prince
George's County; and recommend holistic and sustainable solutions to address the needs of the
senior citizen population in Prince George's County.

WHEREAS, the senior citizen population in Prince George's County represent a significant portion of the community, and their well-being and quality of life are of utmost importance; and

WHEREAS, it is imperative to address the diverse needs of senior citizens comprehensively, including but not limited to senior tax credits, access to affordable and equitable healthcare, food insecurity, housing, transportation, social services, asset planning, fraud prevention education and recreational opportunities; and

WHEREAS, establishing a task force dedicated to addressing the challenges faced by senior citizens will facilitate the development and implementation of holistic solutions that enhance their quality of life and promote their overall well-being; and

WHEREAS, the County Council is committed to its responsibility to provide holistic services and benefits to meet the needs of the County's current and future senior citizen population; and

WHEREAS, the needs and care for the County's senior citizen population are distinct from the County's general non senior citizen population; and

WHEREAS, a collaborative and multi-disciplinary approach involving various stakeholders is necessary to develop effective solutions tailored to the unique needs of senior citizens in our community; and

WHEREAS, Section 506 of the Charter provides that the Council may appoint, for designated periods, one or more temporary advisory boards of citizens of the County who shall assist in the coordination of County policies and programs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the Holistic and Sustainable Solutions for Senior Citizens Task Force is hereby established and shall (1) conduct a comprehensive assessment of the needs (i.e., housing, financial and tax policies, etc.) and challenges faced by senior citizens in Prince George's County; (2) develop a strategic plan outlining holistic solutions to address the identified needs and challenges; (3) collaborate with relevant stakeholders, including government agencies, non-profit organizations, and community groups, to implement the strategic plan; (4) submit quarterly updates to the County Council and County Executive; and (5) provide an annual report identifying equitable and sustainable solutions to address the needs of the senior citizen population in Prince George's County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Holistic and Sustainable Solutions for Senior Citizens Task Force shall consist of eleven (11) members, representing various sectors and interests, including but not limited to:

- (1) A representative from the Prince George's County Association of Realtors;
- (2) A representative from the Maryland State Department of Assessment and Taxation;
- (3) A representative from the AARP Suitland Chapter #939;
- (4) A representative from the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission;
- (5) The Director of Finance or the Director's representative;
- (6) The Director of Social Services or the Director's representative;
- (7) The Director of Family Services or the Director's representative;
- (8) The County Auditor or the County Auditor's representative; and
- (9) Three (3) senior citizens who reside in Prince George's County and represent the Northern, Central and Southern geographic areas of the County, respectively. The Chair of the County Council shall appoint one senior representative to serve as Chair.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Holistic and Sustainable Solutions for Senior

1	Citizens Task Force shall meet quarterly; with the first meeting commencing the first week of
2	October 2024. Additionally, meetings may be called as deemed necessary by the Chairperson.
3	BE IT FURTHER RESOVLED that the Holistic and Sustainable Solutions for Senior
4	Citizens Task Force shall present its findings and recommendations to the County Council on or
5	before February 28, 2025.
6	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Holistic and Sustainable Solutions for Senior
7	Citizens Task Force's recommendations shall be considered by the County Council and County
8	Executive and taken under advisement to decide implementation of the proposed
9	recommendations.
10	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council Administrator shall assign appropriate
11	technical and administrative support staff to assist the Holistic and Sustainable Solutions for
12	Senior Citizens Task Force in its work.
