Amendment Introduced by Council on October 21, 2025

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

1. **Amendment No. 1**

Makes changes to the purpose paragraph.

On page 1, in line 2, strike “Speed Humps” and substitute “Traffic Calming Devices”; on page 1, in line 4, after “studies” insert “by certain initiation”; on page 1, in line 4, after “of”, strike “speed humps and other” and substitute “traffic calming devices”; on page 1, in line 5, after “requests” insert “and a certain approval”; on page 1, in line 7, strike “speed humps” and substitute “traffic calming devices”; on page 1, in line 8, strike “speed humps” and substitute “traffic calming devices”; on page 1, in line 8, after “a” insert “certain consultation and for a”; on page 1, in line 10, after the first “a”, insert “certain consultation and for a”; and on page 1, in line 12, strike “speed humps” and insert “traffic calming devices”.

2. **Amendment No. 2**

Makes technical changes to the bill.

On page 3, in line 25, strike “(c)” and substitute “(d) . On page 4, in line 26, strike “(f)” and substitute “(g)”.

1 **3. Amendment No. 3**

2 **Changes the term “speed humps” to “traffic calming devices”.**

3 On page 2, in line 8, strike “Speed humps;” and substitute “Traffic calming devices”; on
 4 page 2, in line 16, after “of”, strike “speed humps” and substitute “traffic calming devices,
 5 a”; on page 2, in line 16, after “other”, insert “traffic calming devices”, on page 2, in line
 6 16, strike “a”; on page 2, in line 17, strike “is”; on page 2, in line 21, strike “speed hump”
 7 and substitute “traffic calming device”; on page 2, in line 25, after “install” strike “speed
 8 humps” and substitute “traffic calming device”; on page 2, in line 27, after “(d)”, insert
 9 “(1)”; on page 2, in line 27, strike “speed humps” and substitute “traffic calming devices”;
 10 and on page 3, in line 5, strike “speed hump” and substitute “traffic calming device”.

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 12 **4. Amendment No. 4**

13 **Provides for a request of a County Council Member or an associated County**
 14 **Council Member’s request on behalf of a Homeowner’s Association to initiate a**
 15 **Traffic Calming Device Study.**

16 On page 2, in line 21, strike “a Homeowner’s Association (HOA) and”; and on page 2, in
 17 line 22, insert “the associated County Councilmember or at the associated
 18 Councilmember’s request on behalf of a Homeowner’s Association (HOA)”.

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 20 **5. Amendment No. 5**

21 **Requires an engineering study for approval for locating a traffic calming device.**

22 On page 2, in line 28, after “approved” insert “after an engineering study; and”.

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 24 **6. Amendment No. 6**

25 **Installation of a traffic calming device requires a favorable vote by a majority of**
 26 **those present by affected parties.**

27 On page 3, beginning in line 1, insert “(2) after a majority of the members attending an
 28 official, duly constituted, meeting of the HOA, Civic Association, or those property
 29 owners on an affected street in the absence of a HOA or Civic Association vote in favor
 30 of the installation.”.

1 **7. Amendment No. 7**

2 **Strikes the resolution requirement and requires quarterly reports of requests and**
3 **disposition of requests for traffic calming devices.**

4 On page 3, in line 4, after “the”, strike “Prince George’s County Council, by resolution”
5 and substitute “associated County Councilmember in which the”; on page 3, in line 6,
6 after “located.”, insert “Upon the receipt of the letter of approval, installation will be
7 scheduled. The DPWT Director or their designee shall prepare a report of all requests for
8 traffic calming devices and the disposition of the request organized by councilmanic
9 district and calendar year. This report shall be presented to the County Council on a
10 quarterly basis.”.

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12 **8. Amendment No. 8**

13 **Provides that the DPWT Director shall consult with the Police Department**
14 **regarding whether the DPWT will install speed monitoring systems on a particular**
15 **roadway and an estimated time for installation.**

16 On page 3, in line 21, after “and” insert “the Department”. On page 4, in line 22, after
17 “and” insert “the Department”.
