For the purpose of approving the application by Prince George's County, Maryland, to the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development for funding through the Community Legacy Financial Assistance Fund.

WHEREAS, Prince George's County, Maryland (the "County") recognizes that there is a significant need for reinvestment and revitalization of the communities of the County; and

WHEREAS, Section 6-201 through Section 6-211 of the Housing and Community Development Article, Annotated Code of Maryland, established the Community Legacy Program to preserve existing communities as desirable places to live and conduct business and provide financial assistance to sponsors for the development of community legacy plans or community legacy projects; and

WHEREAS, Section 6-206(b)(1) of the Housing and Community Development Article, Annotated Code of Maryland, provides that the Community Legacy Board may not approve an application for participation in the Community Legacy Program unless the application is approved by the political subdivision; and

WHEREAS, the County is applying to the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development, Community Legacy Program, for funds to carry out its "Auth Road Reconstruction Project" (the "Project") in the Camp Springs community (the "Area"), as described in Attachment "A" and incorporated by reference; and

WHEREAS, the Project will provide continuous sidewalk, bike lanes and street trees along a major thoroughfare in the Area, enhancing safety, improving aesthetics and allowing the County to

1 address major storm drainage problems, and thereby contributing to the reinvestment and 2 revitalization in the Area; and 3 WHEREAS, the Area is located within a priority funding area under Section 5-7B-02 of the 4 Smart Growth Act and the Project will conform to the local zoning code; and 5 WHEREAS, the County Executive, by his signature, expresses approval of the application 6 submitted by Prince George's County, Maryland. 7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the County Council of Prince George's 8 County, Maryland, hereby approves the application of Prince George's County, Maryland 9 submitted to the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development for participation in the Community Legacy Program in the approximate amount of \$200,000. 10 11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be sent to the Secretary of the 12 Department of Housing and Community Development of the State of Maryland for consideration by the Community Legacy Board. 13 Adopted this 15th day of November, 2011.
