**RESOLUTION**

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 State of Maryland Community Legacy Program

3 For the purpose of approving the application by Prince George’s County, Maryland, to the

4 Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development for funding through the

5 Community Legacy Financial Assistance Fund.

6 WHEREAS, Prince George’s County, Maryland (the “County”) recognizes that there is a

7 significant need for reinvestment and revitalization of the communities of the County; and

8 WHEREAS, Section 6-201 through Section 6-211 of the Housing and Community

9 Development Article, Annotated Code of Maryland, established the Community Legacy Program

10 to preserve existing communities as desirable places to live and conduct business and provide

11 financial assistance to sponsors for the development of community legacy plans or community

12 legacy projects; and

13 WHEREAS, Section 6-206(b)(1) of the Housing and Community Development Article,

14 Annotated Code of Maryland, provides that the Community Legacy Board may not approve an

15 application for participation in the Community Legacy Program unless the application is

16 approved by the political subdivision; and

17 WHEREAS, the County is applying to the Maryland Department of Housing and Community

18 Development, Community Legacy Program, for funds to carry out its “Auth Road Reconstruction

19 Project” (the “Project”) in the Camp Springs community (the “Area”), as described in Attachment

20 “A” and incorporated by reference; and

21 WHEREAS, the Project will provide continuous sidewalk, bike lanes and street trees along a

22 major thoroughfare in the Area, enhancing safety, improving aesthetics and allowing the County to

1 address major storm drainage problems, and thereby contributing to the reinvestment and  
2 revitalization in the Area; and

3 WHEREAS, the Area is located within a priority funding area under Section 5-7B-02 of the  
4 Smart Growth Act and the Project will conform to the local zoning code; and

5 WHEREAS, the County Executive, by his signature, expresses approval of the application  
6 submitted by Prince George’s County, Maryland.

7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the County Council of Prince George's  
8 County, Maryland, hereby approves the application of Prince George’s County, Maryland  
9 submitted to the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development for  
10 participation in the Community Legacy Program in the approximate amount of \$200,000.

11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be sent to the Secretary of the  
12 Department of Housing and Community Development of the State of Maryland for consideration  
13 by the Community Legacy Board.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: AUTH ROAD RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT:

Using Community Legacy funds, the County will develop a concept plan for the reconstruction of Auth Road. Funding of this project, a priority of those living and working within the Camp Springs area, will allow the County to develop a Complete Street concept that, when constructed, would provide continuous sidewalk, bike lanes, and street trees leading to enhanced safety and aesthetic improvements. The Auth Road project is one of the community infrastructure needs identified within the County's approved BRAC Revitalization and Incentive Zone, and will play an important role in revitalizing and reinvesting in one of our older communities.
