PUBLIC SAFETY & FISCAL MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE REPORT Date: 3/12/03

Committee Vote, Favorable, 5-0, (In favor: Councilmembers Exum, Bland, Hendershot, Knotts, and Peters.)

This bill will amend the County Code by deleting obsolete sections that pertain to the Office of the Sheriff and the Department of Corrections. Each of the provisions to be deleted is either covered by or in conflict with existing state law or is no longer relevant.

The Office of Law has reviewed this legislation and find it to be in proper form with no legal impediments to its enactment.

There should not be any negative fiscal impact on the County as a result of enacting CB-13-2003.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT

(Includes reason for proposal, as well as any unique statutory requirements)

The last review of the Code provisions relating to the Office of the Sheriff was conducting in 1977 in conjunction with legislation providing for the Department of Corrections. Since that time, numerous provisions of local law have been superceded by State law. The proposed legislation deletes obsolete provisions of the County Code relating to the Office of the Sheriff.
