REPORT: Favorable 3-0: Council Members Hawkins, Ivey, and Taveras. Absent: Franklin and Harrison.

The Health, Human Services and Public Safety Committee met on November 6, 2019 to consider the appointments of Tiffany C. Harkless and Toni Paster-Dupree to the Commission for Individuals with Disabilities for Prince George's County. The Commission helps the County ensure that it is in compliance with the requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act and consults with government agencies, residents and businesses to resolve disability issues in Prince George's County.

During the meeting the Appointments Liaison introduced the appointees and provided the committee with background information about Ms. Harkless and Ms. Paster-Dupree. The nominees then introduced themselves, provided introductory remarks and answered questions from the committee members. The Director of the Office of Family Services also joined the discussion and expressed her support for this Commission which she says is doing incredible work.

After discussion, the Health, Human Services and Public Safety committee voted the appointments of those named out favorably, 3-0.
