RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION concerning

Super Bowl XLII (2008) - Governmental Services and Ambush Marketing

For the purpose of providing all governmental services reasonably necessary to the success of

Super Bowl XLII (2008) and related Official Events within Prince George's County, Maryland in

conjunction with the Host Committee and Federal, State and local governments and any other

public or private entity, and providing that Prince George's County, Maryland agrees that it shall

not authorize any sponsorships of Prince George's County, Maryland during the two weeks prior,

through the week following, of Super Bowl XLII (2008) and related Official Events upon a

successful bid by the Washington, D.C. Super Bowl Host Committee for Super Bowl XLII

(2008).

WHEREAS, the National Football League (the "League") owns, produces and controls the annual professional football championship game known as the "Super Bowl", the largest national annual sporting event held in this country; National Football League Properties, LLC ("NFLP" or, together with the League, the "NFL") owns, produces and controls the "NFL Experience," and along with other NFL Affiliates owns, produces and controls certain other events associated with the Super Bowl ("Official Events"); and

WHEREAS, FedExField (the "Stadium") is located at 1600 FedEx Way, Landover, Maryland 20785; and

WHEREAS, Prince George's County, Maryland has within its jurisdiction facilities and their premises, access roads, thoroughfares and other areas which may be used for the purposes of organizing, financing, promoting, accommodating, staging and conducting Super Bowl XLII (2008) and its related Official Events and activities; and

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WHEREAS, hosting the Super Bowl and Official Events will generate goodwill, enhance the worldwide renown and prestige of Prince George's County, Maryland, create temporary jobs and create substantial beneficial economic and fiscal activity; and

WHEREAS, the NFL has requested a declaration of support from Prince George's County, Maryland and certain guarantees concerning the performance of reasonably necessary governmental services in connection with the Super Bowl and related Official Events as part of the formal bid made by the Washington, D.C. Super Bowl Host Committee with Prince George's County, Maryland to be designated as a site for Super Bowl XLII (2008), with the Stadium and related facilities located in Prince George's County, Maryland.

SECTION 1. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the governing body of Prince George's County, Maryland welcomes Super Bowl XLII (2008) and related Official Events to its jurisdiction and to that end declares its full support of the efforts of the Host Committee to have Prince George's County, Maryland selected as the site for Super Bowl XLII (2008), with the Stadium and related facilities located in Prince George's County, Maryland; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, upon designation of Prince George's County, Maryland as a site for Super Bowl XLII (2008), with the Stadium and related facilities located in Prince George's County, Maryland, and at all times thereafter, Prince George's County, Maryland, and its agencies, departments and personnel, in conjunction with the Host Committee and Federal, State and local governments and any other public or private entities, agree to provide all governmental services (including without limitation public safety, security, fire and medical emergency, traffic, decorative display and public works/street maintenance services and supplies) reasonably necessary to the success of Super Bowl XLII (2008) and related Official Events within Prince George's County, Maryland (whether, recognizing the uniqueness and extraordinary scope of the Super Bowl, such services are below, equal to or beyond the normal level and range of governmental services usually provided for events held within the jurisdiction), including all planning, training or deployment activities related to the provision of such services, all at no cost or expense to the NFL or the two participating Teams (the "Teams"), except as otherwise provided in the final bid for Super Bowl XLII (2008) by the Washington, D.C. Super Bowl Host Committee. Further, the NFL and the Teams shall not incur liability, subject to the applicable laws of the State of Maryland, and except as otherwise provided in the

final bid for Super Bowl XLII (2008) by the Washington, D.C. Super Bowl Host Committee. Prince George's County, Maryland shall not incur liability nor indemnify the NFL or Teams for any claims of liability from negligence or willful misconduct of the NFL or the Teams, their agents, officers or employees; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Prince George's County, Maryland agrees that neither the NFL, the Teams, nor any director, shareholder, officer, agent, employee or other representative of the NFL or the Teams shall be held accountable for or incur any financial responsibility or liability of any kind or nature whatsoever in connection with the governmental services planned and/or provided by Prince George's County, Maryland relating to Super Bowl XLII (2008) and related Official Events, except as otherwise provided in the final bid for Super Bowl XLII (2008) by the Washington, D.C. Super Bowl Host Committee. Further, the NFL and the Teams shall not incur liability, subject to the applicable laws of the State of Maryland, and except as otherwise provided in the final bid for Super Bowl XLII (2008) by the Washington, D.C. Super Bowl Host Committee. Prince George's County, Maryland shall not incur liability nor indemnify the NFL or Teams for any claims of liability from negligence or willful misconduct of the NFL or the Teams, their agents, officers or employees; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Prince George's County, Maryland agrees that it shall not authorize any sponsorships of Prince George's County, Maryland during the two weeks prior, through the week following, of Super Bowl XLII (2008) and related Official Events; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon designation of Prince George's County, Maryland as the site for Super Bowl XLII (2008) and related Official Events, with the Stadium and related facilities located in Prince George's County, Maryland, and at all times thereafter, Prince George's County, Maryland reserves the right to enter into agreements with the Host Committee and Federal, State and local governments and any other public or private entity to provide all governmental services reasonably necessary to the success of Super Bowl XLII (2008) and related Official Events within Prince George's County, Maryland and to negotiate with the Host Committee and Federal, State and local governments and any other public or private entity for the reimbursement of costs of providing required governmental services.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall take effect upon the date of adoption and that Section 1 of this Resolution shall take effect upon the date of receipt of a successful bid by the Washington, D.C. Super Bowl Host Committee for Super Bowl

1	XLII (2008). In the event that the designation of Prince George's County, Maryland as the site		
2	for Super Bowl XLII (2008) and related Official Events, with the Stadium and related facilities		
3	located in Prince George's County, Maryland does not occur, the provisions of this Resolution		
4	shall be deemed null and void and of no further force and effect.
