BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:

The Prince George's County Council on October 7, 2025 adopted CR-91-2025, establishing Accessory Dwelling Units Task Force, a fifteen (15) member group. The Task Force was established with the mission of reviewing and evaluating current practices relating to legislation for development of accessory dwelling units in Prince George's County and making recommendations to the Prince George's County Council.

CR-91-2025 provided that the Task Force shall present its report and recommendation to the Council on or before February 28, 2026. Due to the comprehensive and complex nature of the endeavor, more time is needed in order to give the Task Force recommendations to be reported proper coverage.

The Task Force requests that its term shall be extended to May 1, 2026.
