For the purpose o	f establishing spending control limits on the Fiscal Year 2027 Water and Sewer
Operating and Ca	pital Budgets of the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission (WSSC).
WHEREAS	during the Fiscal Year 1994 Bi-County budget process, the Montgomery and
Prince George's C	ounty Councils established a Bi-County Working Group to recommend
changes that would	d control the growth of debt and maintain future rate increases at WSSC close
to the level of infl	ation; and
WHEREAS.	the Working Group's January 1994 Report recommended the establishment of
a spending afford	ability process; and
WHEREAS.	the Prince George's County Council endorsed the entire Working Group's
report through the	adoption of CR-12-1994 and the Montgomery County Council endorsed part
of the report's rec	ommendations through Resolution #12-1558; and
WHEREAS.	the Councils jointly endorsed in concept the January 1994 Working Group
Report spending a	affordability process; and
WHEREAS.	both Councils endorsed the utilization of the spending affordability process
beginning with th	e formulation of the Fiscal Year 1996 budget; and
WHEREAS.	the Spending Affordability Working Group, consisting of the staffs of the
Montgomery and	Prince George's County Councils and both County Executive's offices, make
certain recommen	dations on the WSSC Fiscal Year 2027 Operating and Capital Budgets; and

1	WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Council and the Montgomery County Council		
2	have reviewed the information compiled by the staff relating to spending control limits on the		
3	percentage of water and sewer increase; new debt; debt service and operating expenditures; and		
4	WHEREAS, the spending control limits for WSSC's FY 2027 Capital and Operating		
5	Budgets were discussed on October 9, 2025, by the Transportation, Infrastructure, Energy an		
6	Environment Committee; and		
7	WHEREAS, the spending control limits for WSSC's FY 2027 Capital and Operating		
8	Budgets were further discussed on October 28, 2025, by the County Council resulting in a		
9	reduction in the Water & Sewer Combined Rate Increase to 5.0%, which further resulted in related		
10	adjustments, as noted below.		
11	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's		
12	County, Maryland, that the Prince George's County Council hereby endorses the following		
13	spending control limits for the Fiscal Year 2027 Water and Sewer Operating and Capital Budgets		
14	of the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission:		
15	Water & Sewer Combined Rate Increase: 5.0%		
16	New Water & Sewer Debt Issuance: \$491,102,000		
17	Total Water & Sewer Debt Service: \$388,466,000		
18	Total Water & Sewer Expenditures: \$1,183,498,000
