RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 Compensation of the Chairman of the Prince George's County Planning Board
3 For the purpose of establishing and providing for the compensation of the Chairman of the
4 Prince George's County Planning Board.

5 WHEREAS, Article 28, Section 2-104 of the Annotated Code of Maryland governs the
6 compensation of members of the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission;
7 and

8 WHEREAS, upon recommendation from the County Executive, the County Council may
9 authorize whatever supplementary compensation as may be deemed appropriate for the
10 Chairman of the Prince George's County Planning Board, designated to serve on a full-time
11 basis; and

12 WHEREAS, the County Executive has recommended the compensation for that position;
13 now, therefore,

14 SECTION 1. BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
15 Maryland, that the salary for the full-time Chairman of the Prince George's County Planning
16 Board be and the same is hereby established at the maximum rate for Grade
17 G-38 in the General Schedule of the Prince George's County Salary Plan as it may be adjusted
18 from time to time.

19 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, in addition to salary, the full-time
20 Chairman of the Prince George's County Planning Board shall be entitled to the fringe benefits
21 for full-time employees of the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission and
22 shall accrue annual leave on the basis of thirty (30) days per year.
