- (B) The property is contiguous to an existing mass transit rail station operated by the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority (WMATA);
- (C) A Detailed Site Plan shall be approved in accordance with Part 3, Division 9 of this Subtitle;
- (D) Regulations concerning the height of structure, lot size and coverage, frontage, setbacks, density, and other requirements of the C-S-C Zone shall not apply.

 All such requirements shall be established and shown on the Detailed Site Plan; and
- (E) Density regulations shall be in accordance with the R-10 Zone for multifamily dwellings.
