REPORT: Committee Vote: Favorable, 9-0 (In favor: Chair Ivey, Council Members Blegay, Burroughs, Dernoga, Fisher, Harrison, Olson, Oriadha, and Watson)

The County Council convened as the Committee of the Whole on October 22, 2024, to consider CR-093-2024. The PHED Committee Director summarized the purpose of the legislation and informed the Committee of written comments received on referral. As presented on October 1, 2024, the resolution creates a Community Housing Trust Task Force to focus on the actions needed to establish a Community Housing Trust in the County in order to make more affordable housing opportunities for County residents, providing for the membership of the Task Force; providing for certain research and policy recommendations and report; providing for the staffing of the Task Force; and generally regarding Community Housing Trusts.

The Budget and Policy Analysis Division provided a fiscal and policy note stating that CR-093-2024 will likely have a slight adverse fiscal impact, requiring some administrative expenditures for staffing and technical supplies for operations. As with other council-created task forces, this additional cost is expected to be absorbed by the existing legislative branch budget.

The indirect fiscal impact will be favorable because a Community Housing Trust would create an affordable housing tool to provide homeownership opportunities to low-income residents.

The policy and fiscal note listed two questions for the Council Committee of the Whole's consideration. The questions are as follows:

- 1. Is this a duplicative action since the Comprehensive Housing Strategy has already researched what it takes to establish a Community Housing Trust?
- 2. What further research will be necessary to carry this through?

Ms. Sakinda Skinner, County Council Liaison with the County Executive's Office, stated that the Administration supports CR-093-2024.

On motion of Council Member Olson, seconded by Council Watson, the Prince George's County Council, sitting as the Committee of the Whole, voted 9-0 favorably on CR-093-2024.
