### REPORT:

The Committee of the Whole convened on June 21, 2016, to discuss CB-48-2016. The Zoning and Legislative Counsel provided an orientation on the purpose of the bill, which is to refine the licensing and regulatory requirements for Special Food Service Facilities – Mobile Units that operate at Food Truck Hubs where designated in the County. Staff then explained that, after consultation with the sponsor and staff of the Office of Law, the bill’s sponsor offered certain amendments to CB-48-2016 (DR-1), as follows:

1. On page 2, in line 3, after “as appropriate,” add “and the Council Member for the area of the Food Truck Hub,”
2. On page 4, in lines 20–21, remove the brackets around Subsection (a).

After discussion by the committee members, Council Member Toles offered the following refinement to the proposed language for insertion on Page 2, in line 3 set forth in paragraph 1, above:

1. On page 2, in line 3, after “as appropriate,” add “as well as a letter signed by the Council Member for the area of the food truck hub authorizing that Food Truck Hub” and on page 2 in line 4 strike “which includes support”.

The Committee of Whole voted 6-0 for a favorable recommendation as to CB-48-2016 with the amendments set forth in revised paragraph 1 above, as well as the amendments proposed in paragraph 2, above. (In favor: Council Members Glaros, Franklin, Lehman, Patterson, Taveras and Toles; Absent: Council Members Davis, Harrison and Turner)
