- (A) The relocation of such uses, provided the last site on which the use was located was in the I-1 Zone, not more than three (3) miles from the subject property, is currently used by a public entity for a mass transit facility, and was acquired prior to June 1, 1993; or
- (B) A property of 15,000 to 20,000 square feet, formerly the site of a full-service gas station, abutting on at least one side property in the C-S-C Zone, limited to repair of vehicles with a maximum gross vehicle weight of 17,000 pounds; or
- (C) A property of 13,000 to 14,999 square feet, if the property was formerly at least 15,000 square feet and is currently less than 15,000 square feet as the result of land acquisition by a public entity for street purposes, formerly the site of a full-service gas station, abutting on at least one side property in the C-S-C Zone, limited to repair of vehicles with a maximum gross vehicle weight of 17,000 pounds.
