RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 The Tax Rates for FY 2003-2004

3 For the purpose of imposing and levying the tax rates and causing to be raised the amount of
 4 taxes required by the adopted budget so as to balance the budget as to proposed income and
 5 expenditures for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2003; and to set forth the State tax levy and the
 6 Stormwater Management District tax levy.

7 WHEREAS, Section 811 of Article VIII (Budget and Finance) of the Charter for Prince
 8 George's County, Maryland requires that when the County Budget shall have been finally
 9 adopted in the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance, the Council shall, by separate
 10 Resolution, levy and cause to be raised the amount of taxes required to balance the budget as to
 11 proposed income and expenditures; and

12 WHEREAS, the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance, was adopted, transmitted to
 13 the County Executive pursuant to Section 411 of the Charter, and has now become law; and

14 WHEREAS, the Current Expense Budget as submitted by the County Executive, an
 15 authenticated copy of which, as amended, was incorporated by reference and made a part of the
 16 Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance, will require the amount of taxes produced by the
 17 levy of the rate as hereby set; and

18 WHEREAS, Sections 10-183 through 10-186.02 of the Prince George's County Code set
 19 forth the procedures for the reduction of the rate of County property taxes levied in
 20 municipalities to reflect the services and programs that are performed by the municipalities
 21 instead of similar County services and programs; and

22 WHEREAS, Section 10-106 of the Prince George's County Code requires the levy shall be

set forth in such a manner as to show the total property tax rate and that portion of the rate attributable to the budget for Prince George's County Public Schools; and

WHEREAS, the County must include in the annual property tax bills a State levy as certified by the State Board of Public Works and a levy for the Prince George's County Stormwater Management District; and

WHEREAS, state law requires that the Stormwater Management District tax be imposed only upon properties that are provided either directly or indirectly stormwater management services.

SECTION 1. BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that there is hereby imposed and levied a tax upon each One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) of assessed value of all assessable property, real and personal, assessed according to the Laws of Maryland and subject to taxation in Prince George's County, at the following rates:

Personal Property Tax – Two Dollars and forty cents (\$2.40).

Real Property Tax – Ninety six cents (\$0.96).

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the levy for the County property tax in municipalities shall be adjusted as follows:

18 SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that included in the total County tax rates is
 19 that portion attributable to the budget for Prince George's County Schools, at the following rates:

20 Personal Property Tax – One Dollar and fourteen and seventy-five one hundredths cents

21 (\$1.1475).

22 Real Property Tax – Forty-five and ninety one hundredths cents (\$0.4590).

23 SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the levy to be included on the annual tax
 24 bill as submitted by the State Board of Public Works for the State tax for each One Hundred
 25 Dollars (\$100.00) of assessed value is at the following rates:

26 Property of Public Utilities – Thirty-three cents (\$0.3300).

27 Real Property Tax – Thirteen and twenty hundredth cents (0.1320).

28 SECTION 5. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the levy for the Prince George's County
 29 Stormwater Management District for each One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) of assessed value
 30 shall be at the following rates:

31 Taxing Area 1 - Personal Property Tax – Thirteen and fifty hundredths cents (\$0.1350).

1 Taxing Area 1 - Real Property Tax – Five and forty hundredths cents (\$0.0540).

2 Taxing Area 2 - Personal Property Tax – Three cents (\$0.0300).

3 Taxing Area 2 - Real Property Tax – One and twenty hundredths cents (\$0.0120).

4 SECTION 6. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the rate of tax levied and imposed by
5 this resolution for semiannual payment of State, County, and special taxing district property
6 taxes on owner-occupied residential property shall take effect and be in force for the fiscal year
7 beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2004.
