BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT

Section 1-204, Article 29 of the Annotated Code of Maryland requires the joint approval of the Prince George's and Montgomery County Councils for changes to the submitted WSSC operating and capital budgets. This resolution recommends the WSSC adopt a zero rate increase in water and sewer rates for the fifth consecutive year. The joint approval of both Councils is required to increase operating expenditures above the amount approved for FY03, \$465,835,000. Any changes to the Operating or Capital Budget categories which exceed the approved categories by 5% or greater requires prior Council approval. Below the 5% limit, the Commission may authorize the transfer of funds between categories.
