This resolution will amend the Salary Plan in Salary Schedule A for employees represented by Council 67, AFSCME, AFL-CIO, and its affiliated Local 2462 (employees in labor and trade classifications in the Department of Public Works & Transportation - DPW&T, Department of Environmental Resources - DER, Office of Central Services - OCS) and Local 2735 (employees in various professional, paraprofessional, clerical and administrative classifications in DPW&T, DER, Department of Family Services and Department of Housing and Community Development) and reflects modifications of the two year collective bargaining agreement (FY2002-FY2003).

The highlights of the Salary Plan and the fiscal impact are included in CB-88-2001.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT

This resolution will amend the Salary Plan in Salary Schedule A for certain employees represented by Council 67, American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, (AFSCME), AFL-CIO, and its affiliated Locals 2462 and 2735. This resolution is companion legislation to the bill to approve the collective bargaining agreements between the County and Council 67, American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO and its affiliated Locals 2462 and 2735 for Fiscal Years 2002 and 2003. This resolution also reflects modifications of the agreements.
