**BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT**

Subtitle 5 of Title 2 (Agriculture) of the Annotated Code of Maryland provides for the establishment of the Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation Foundation and a procedure for the formation of agricultural districts. This petition is the fourth to be filed in Prince George's County since the inception of the program. To date, no districts have been established in Prince George's County. Within 120 days after receipt of a petition, the County governing body must decide whether to recommend that the Foundation approve the district. State law also requires that the County governing body hold a public hearing prior to its action.
