DeVaughn requested the establishment of a agricultural preservation district for approximately 112.9720 (Tax Map 129/GridB4/Parcel 14/Tax Account 04-0252940) located at 15601 St. Thomas Church Road near the Merkle Wildlife Management Area in Upper Marlboro in Prince George's County, Maryland, as generally shown on the attached location map; and

WHEREAS, the petition were referred to the Prince George's County Agricultural Preservation Advisory Board and the Prince George's County Planning Board for review and recommendation; and

WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Agricultural Preservation Advisory Board found that the William D. and Catherine L. DeVaughn property met the qualifying criteria for productivity, size and location as set by the Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation Foundation, and recommended establishment of the agricultural district on January 31, 2008; and

WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Planning Board found that the establishment of the proposed agricultural district is compatible with existing and approved county plans and recommended approval of the petition and establishment of the district on March 31, 2008; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's

County, Maryland, that Tax Map 129/GridB4/Parcel 14/Tax Account 04-0252940, described in the agricultural district petition filed by William D. and Catherine L. DeVaughn is recommended to the Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation Foundation for approval.
