**BILL**

AN ACT concerning

Classification Review Requests

FOR the purpose of suspending the submission, processing and implementation of classification review requests of encumbered positions (desk audits) for a certain period.

WHEREAS, Section 16-116 of the Prince George's County Code and Administrative Procedure 244 delineate the policies and procedures governing the submission, processing and implementation of classification review requests of encumbered positions; and

WHEREAS, a classification review request is defined in Administrative Procedure 244 as a request for a desk audit which determines the proper allocation of a position based on an analysis of the assigned duties and responsibilities; and

WHEREAS, Classification review requests of encumbered positions are permitted in the months of June and December each year in accordance with Administrative Procedure 244; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the submission, processing and implementation of classification review requests will have a significant and unbudgeted fiscal impact on the County; now, therefore

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that, notwithstanding the provisions of Section 16-116 of the Prince George's County Code and current County procedures, the submission, processing and implementation of all classification review requests of encumbered positions (desk audits) be and the same are hereby suspended during Fiscal Year 1992.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the provisions of this Act shall expire on June 30, 1992, and be of no further force and effect without further legislative act.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45) calendar days after it becomes law and shall be retroactively effective to July 1, 1991.
