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**REPORT:** Favorable 8-0 (In Favor: Council Members Glaros, Davis, Franklin, Harrison, Lehman, Patterson, Taveras and Turner; Absent: Toles)

The County Council convened as the Committee of the Whole on July 10, 2018 to consider CR-16-2018.

CR-16-2018 is a resolution to approve the updated County-wide Hazard Mitigation Plan. This updated plan is a necessary requirement of the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) to remain eligible for federal mitigation for natural hazards. This is the first time the mitigation plan has been updated since 2010.

The resolution lays out what is included in the mitigation plan pursuant to federal guidelines which are required.

Ronald Gill, Deputy Director, Office of Homeland Security, briefed the Council on the mitigation plan and answered questions posed by Councilmembers.

After discussion, the County Council, sitting as the Committee of the Whole reported CR-16-2018 out favorably 8-0.
