RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 Accounting of ICE Detainees in Prince George's County

3 For the purpose of reaffirming the County Council's commitment to the protection of civil rights
4 and civil liberties for all people; and directing that the County partner with a local non-profit
5 entity to develop a roster of all residents of the County in potential Immigration and Customs
6 Enforcement ("ICE") custody.

7 WHEREAS, Prince George's County strives to maintain and uphold its diverse, inclusive,
8 world-class community where people unite to form a caring, learning, participating, sustainable
9 community in which each person is important; and

10 WHEREAS, public trust in law enforcement officers and their reciprocal respect for the
11 rule of law are vital to promoting public safety; and

12 WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Council remains firmly committed to the
13 protection of civil rights and civil liberties for all people; and

14 WHEREAS, in order to promote the health, safety, and well-being of the citizens and
15 residents of Prince George's County, the County Council finds that there is a need for the County
16 to partner with a non-profit entity to develop a list of County residents potentially detained by
17 ICE for public use and access; and

18 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 1017 of the County Charter, a Resolution has the force and
19 effect of law but of a temporary or administrative character.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's
21 County, Maryland, that a partnership be established with a non-profit entity for the purpose of


1 developing a publicly accessible list of County residents that are potentially detained in ICE
2 custody.

3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that funding for this purpose shall be made from the Non-
4 Departmental Fund of the County Budget.
