<u>CR-7-2003 – A RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE 2001 WATER AND SEWER PLAN</u>
(<u>DECEMBER 2002 CYCLE OF AMENDMENTS</u>) for the purpose of changing the water and sewer category designations of properties within the 2001 Water and Sewer Plan. - *INTRODUCED*
