RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 Contract Approvals

3 For the purpose of approving certain multiyear contracts in accordance with the Prince George's
4 County Charter section 819 and Subtitle 10 of the Prince George's County Code.

5 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 819 of the Charter for Prince George’s County, the
6 Council must approve, by Resolution, all multiyear contracts exceeding an aggregate of Five
7 Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) for goods and services, as well as all multiyear
8 personal service contracts exceeding an aggregate of One Hundred Thousand Dollars
9 (\$100,000.00) per contractor; and

10 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 10-105 of the Prince George’s County Code, the County
11 Executive must submit, on a yearly basis, a report listing all executory multiyear personal service
12 contracts for the ensuing fiscal year exceeding an aggregate of One Hundred Thousand Dollars
13 (\$100,000.00) per contractor, and all other executory multiyear contracts for the ensuing fiscal
14 year exceeding an aggregate of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) for public review,
15 comment, and approval action by the County Council; and

16 WHEREAS, the Council reviewed the annual report of executory multiyear contracts
17 submitted by the County Executive for FY21, set forth in Attachment A and incorporated as if
18 set forth fully herein; and

19 WHEREAS, due to the effects that the COVID-19 pandemic had on County operations, it
20 has been identified that Attachment A was not subjected to public hearing or public comment
21 prior to being approved as an attachment to the budget; and

22 WHEREAS, the Council finds that, based on its review of Attachment A, an action to

1 approve the included executory multiyear contracts is required in accordance with the
2 prescriptions of County law and to ratify any contracts listed within Attachment A that were
3 executed to date; and

4 WHEREAS, the Council further finds that the approval of such multiyear contracts
5 necessitating Council action is plainly in the public interest.

6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's
7 County, Maryland, that the proposed executory multiyear contracts requiring approval of the
8 County Council, submitted by the County Executive pursuant to Section 819 and Subtitle 10 of
9 the Prince George's County Code and described as set forth in Attachment A hereto, be and the
10 same are hereby APPROVED.

11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Executive is hereby authorized to make
12 such necessary modifications, adjustments, corrections, or any other changes as may be
13 necessary, to finalize the subject agreements in any manner the County Executive may deem
14 necessary or proper but not altering its substance.

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Council hereby ratifies the multiyear
16 contracts identified on Attachment A that have been signed to date.

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution requires a public hearing; the Clerk
18 of the County Council shall be directed to set and give notice of a public hearing on this
19 Resolution in accordance with prescriptions of law.
