BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT

Approval is needed on the Eighteenth Program Year (1992-1993) Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG) and authorization of submission to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to secure the annual entitlement amount of \$5,948,000. There is no impact on County general funds. This annual CDBG application is requested by HUD to be approved by the County Council and submitted to HUD at least 30 days prior to HUD approval of the County's annual grant contract.
