RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION concerning

Extension of Time for the Holistic and Sustainable Solutions for Senior Citizens Task Force
For the purpose of extending the reporting time for the Holistic and Sustainable Solutions for Senior Citizens Task Force and adding [four]five additional members.

WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Council on June 4, 2024, adopted CR-53-2024, establishing the Holistic and Sustainable Solutions for Senior Citizens Task Force (hereinafter referred to as the "Task Force"), an eleven (11) member group, to assess and identify the fundamental needs of the senior citizen population in Prince George's County and recommend holistic and sustainable solutions to address the needs of the senior citizen population in Prince George's County; and

WHEREAS, the Task Force has been delayed in reporting recommendations due to unforeseen circumstances; and

WHEREAS, the County Council desires to provide additional time to the Task Force to assess and identify the fundamental needs of the senior citizen population in Prince George's County and recommend holistic and sustainable solutions to address the needs of the senior citizen population in Prince George's County; and

WHEREAS, the County Council desires to add as additional members, a representative from the Department of Public Works and Transportation, a representative from Adventist HealthCare, a representative from MedStar Southern Maryland Hospital Center, a representative from Luminis Health, and a representative from University of Maryland Capital Region Medical Center.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's

County, Maryland, that the Task Force shall present its report and recommendations to the County Council on or before February 28, 2026.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a representative from the Department of Public Works and Transportation, a representative from Adventist HealthCare, a representative from MedStar Southern Maryland Hospital Center, a representative of Luminis Health, and a representative from University of Maryland Capital Region Medical Center shall serve as members of the Task Force.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, copies of this Resolution be sent by the Clerk of the Council to the County Executive.
