For the purpose of amending the Prince George's County Fiscal Year ("FY") 2016-2020			
Consolidated Plan for Housing and Community Development to modify its Citizen Participation			
Plan to include an expedited process for notice and reasonable opportunity to comment.			
WHEREAS, under the terms of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security			
("CARES") Act, enacted March 27, 2020, part of which attempts to address a wide variety of			
needs including providing shelter to homeless individuals, increasing affordable housing options,			
and maintaining crucial public services during the current public health outbreak through a			
formula grant allocation, Congress designated funding to federal entitlement programs, allocated			
through the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD"); and			
WHEREAS, under the terms of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security,			
("CARES") Act, Prince George's County is qualified as an urban county to receive entitlement			
Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") Program funds in the estimated amount of			
three million, thirty six thousand, nine hundred fifty-eight dollars (\$3,036,958) and Emergency			
Solutions Grants ("ESG") Program funds in the estimated amount of one million, five hundred			
twenty three thousand, nine hundred three dollars (\$1,523,903), to assist in the prevention,			
preparation for and response to the coronavirus crisis; and			
WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD") requires			
jurisdictions that receive assistance under certain community planning and development			

programs to submit a five-year consolidated plan and an annual action plan to the Secretary of

HUD that outlines ways to develop viable communities by: providing decent housing, a suitable living environment, and expanding economic opportunities principally for low- and moderate-income persons; and

WHEREAS, each jurisdiction is required to adopt a citizen participation plan as part of its five-year consolidated plan and annual action plan; and

WHEREAS, a citizen participation plan sets forth the jurisdiction's policies and procedures for citizen participation, and must provide for and encourage citizens to participate in the development of the Assessment of Fair Housing, any revisions to the Assessment of Fair Housing, the five-year consolidated plan, any substantial amendment to the consolidated plan, and the performance report; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 15A-106 and 15A-107 of the Prince George's County Code, the County Executive and the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland adopted CR-08-2015, which set forth the County's FY 2016-2020 Consolidated Plan, along with the County's FY 2016-2020 Citizen Participation Plan; and

WHEREAS, in order to provide an immediate response to the rapidly evolving needs of Prince George's County residents as a result of COVID-19 and given the need to expedite actions in response to the effects of COVID-19, HUD issued a waiver of the statutory requirement related to the provision of reasonable notice and opportunity for citizens to comment on substantial amendments concerning the proposed uses of CDBG, HOME or ESG funds allowing that grantees may reduce its comment period to no less than five (5) days on each substantial amendment; and

WHEREAS, HUD recognized that the efforts to contain COVID-19 require limiting public gatherings, such as those often used to obtain citizen participation, and that there is a need to respond quickly to the growing spread and effects of COVID-19 and therefore, issued a waiver for in-person public hearings and provided flexibility on the provision of reasonable notice and opportunity to comment; and

WHEREAS, the County's FY 2016-2020 Citizen Participation Plan requires the County to submit to HUD, any amendments to the County's five-year Consolidated Plan or Annual Action Plan that constitutes a "substantial change;" and

WHEREAS, the establishment of expedited procedures to draft, propose or amend the Fiveyear Consolidated Plan, Annual Action Plan, and an accelerated Citizen Participation process,

including notice and reasonable opportunity to comment of no less than five (5) days, and the suspension of in-person public hearings requires a "substantial amendment" to the County's FY 2016-2020 Citizen Participation Plan and FY 2020 Annual Action Plan; and

WHEREAS, the County Council shall hold a public hearing for public input on any revision or amendment to the Consolidated Plan and the Annual Action Plan, and approve the amendment by resolution pursuant to Section 15A-106 of the County Code; and

WHEREAS, Attachment "A" consists of the County's FY 2016-2010 Consolidated Plan, as amended, as attached hereto and made part hereof; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive recommends the amendment to the FY 2016-2020 Consolidated Plan to include the modifications to the Citizen Participation Plan detailing an expedited process for notice and reasonable opportunity to comment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the FY 2016-2020 Consolidated Plan for Housing and Community Development, is hereby amended to include the modifications to the Citizen Participation Plan, as described in Attachment "A," as attached hereto and made a part hereof.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon the adoption of this Resolution, it shall be transmitted to the County Executive by the Clerk of the Council, and that the County Executive or his designee is hereby authorized and empowered as the official representative of Prince George's County to submit the amended Annual Action Plan to U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD"), along with all assurances contained therein, to act as necessary in connection with the submission, and to provide such additional information to HUD as may be required.
