NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the draft "Neighborhood Stabilization Program Round 3 ("NSP3"): Substantial Amendment to the Annual Action Plan Fiscal Year 2011, as amended" to restructure, reprogram, and approve NSP3 activities related to housing and community development, a copy of which shall be marked for identification by the Clerk of the County Council and maintained as a permanent record, is hereby approved, in accordance with the activities described in the NSP3 Restructured and Reprogrammed Budget Summary and the draft NSP3 Substantial Amendment to the FY 2011 Annual Action Plan, as amended, Attachments "A" and "B", respectively, as attached hereto and made a part hereof.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Executive or his designee is hereby authorized and empowered as the official representative of Prince George's County to submit the approved "Neighborhood Stabilization Program Round 3 ("NSP3"): Substantial Amendment to the Annual Action Plan Fiscal Year 2011, as amended" to HUD, along with all assurances contained therein, to act as necessary in connection with the submission, and to provide such additional information to HUD as may be required.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Redevelopment Authority of Prince George's County shall identity all residential and commercial properties to be acquired, rehabilitated and demolished with NSP3 funding pursuant to this resolution and shall provide a report no later than December 31, 2013 and shall provide such regular updates as necessary to the County Council.
