AN ORDINANCE concerning

Signs

FOR the purpose of allowing an additional sign for institutional uses.

BY repealing and reenacting with amendments:

Section 27-618,

The Zoning Ordinance of Prince George's County, Maryland,

being also

SUBTITLE 27. ZONING.

The Prince George's County Code (1987 Edition, 1989 Supplement).

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince
George's County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that
part of the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Prince George's

County, Maryland, that Section 27-618 of the Zoning Ordinance of Prince George's County, Maryland, being also Subtitle 27 of the Prince George's County Code, be and the same is hereby repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:

DIVISION 3. DESIGN STANDARDS.

Subdivision 2. Signs for Specific Uses.

Sec. 27-618. Institutional.

- (a) In any zone (except Comprehensive Design and M-X-T Zones) where a church, library, school, hospital, fire station, community center, day care center for children, or other similar institution is allowed, [a] signs may be erected identifying the institution or announcing any events scheduled on the premises. Institutional signs shall meet the following design standards:
 - (1) Maximum area for each sign 48 square feet.
- (2) Maximum height 8 feet above finished grade at base of any freestanding sign.
- (3) Minimum setback 15 feet from adjoining land in any Residential Zone (or land proposed to be used for residential purposes in a Comprehensive Design, Mixed Use, or Planned Community Zone).
- (4) Type allowed $\underline{1}$ freestanding [or] \underline{and} 1 attached to a building.
- (5) Maximum number 1 <u>freestanding and 1 attached to a</u> building, per street the property fronts on (must face street
