It is my pleasure to submit to you and the County Council the appointment of Mr. Daniel Armando Jones to the Prince George's County Police Accountability Board (PAB). The establishment of the PAB is a direct result of HB 670, one of several bills under the Police Accountability Act of 2021, passed in 2021 by the Maryland legislature.

Mr. Daniel Armando Jones, a resident of Hyattsville, currently works as a Legislative Assistant in the Office of Congressman Charlie Crist and maintains a diverse portfolio which includes the areas of Veterans Affairs, Judiciary, Immigration, Transportation & Infrastructure, Education and Animals. 
