### BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:

The proposed Bill under Sec. 28-261. Grading, pollution, drainage, floodplain, and erosion control violation would increase the initial fine for a violation from Two and fifty dollars (\$250) to One

thousand dollars (\$1000.00). Additionally, the 2nd violation of Five hundred dollars (\$500.00) is removed and each subsequent fine is One thousand dollars (\$1000.00) accruing daily while the site is under violation.
