LEGISLATION

CB-21-2011 – (Olson) AN ACT concerning Noise Control For the purpose of authorizing the Director of Environmental Resources to administer and enforce the County's noise control program, adopting by reference certain provisions of the Maryland Department of Environment Noise Regulations, providing a standard of measurement of permissible noise levels in a residential area under certain conditions, and providing civil penalties for violations of this section.

Favorable with amendments: (Council Members Olson, Lehman, Toles and Turner)

CB-33-2011 – (CJ Lammers, M-NCPPC Staff) AN ACT concerning Trees and Vegetation – Tree Canopy Ordinance For the purpose of clarifying applicability requirements, amending regulations, providing certain exemptions, and codifying waiver procedures from requirements of the Tree Canopy Ordinance.

Favorable as amended: (Council Members Olson, Lehman, Toles and Turner)

CB-38-2011 - (Campos) AN ACT concerning Towing Regulation For the purpose of making amendments to certain towing operations in the County; and generally relating to towing regulations.

HELD IN COMMITTEE

CB-40-2011 - (Campos) AN ACT concerning residential parking permit areas for the purpose of providing for residents approval of a designated parking permit area; providing for ineligibility within a designated parking permit area; providing for exemptions within a designated parking permit area; providing for the issuance of permits; requiring the Prince

George's Revenue Authority to promulgate regulations for the administration of parking permit areas; and generally relating to parking permit areas.

Favorable as amended: (Council Members Olson, Lehman, Toles and Turner)

CB-57-2011 – (Lehman) AN ACT concerning the code enforcement and penalties for the purpose of making amendments to certain code enforcement provisions related to violations, fines and appeals in the County; and generally relating to code enforcement.

Favorable as amended: (Council Members Olson, Lehman, Toles and Turner)

CB-58-2011 – (Patterson) AN ACT concerning vacant residential and commercial property maintenance for the purpose of amending registration requirements; providing maintenance standards for residential and commercial property subject to foreclosure; providing for enforcement by the Department of Environmental Resources; and generally relating to maintenance of foreclosed property.

Favorable: (Council Members Lehman, Toles and Turner)
