Committee Vote: Favorable, 4-0 (In favor: Council Members Lehman, Turner, Taveras and Davis)

CR- 18-2016 amends the Prince George's County Fiscal Year ("FY") 2016 Annual Action Plan for Housing and Community Development by reprogramming and reallocating five hundred twenty-two thousand nine hundred nineteen dollars (\$522,919.00) in HOME Investment Partnerships ("HOME") Program funds. These funds are from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development's (HUD) Voluntary Grant Reduction Plan in FY 2016. The Voluntary Grant Reduction Plan that supposed to start in FY 2016 was deferred to FY 2017, thus making available these funds for was by the County in the respective categories outlined in Attachment A and Attachment B.

Staff oriented the Committee on this legislation including the referral comments. Eric Brown and Estella Alexander of the Prince Georges County Department of Housing and Community Development provided comments and answered questions by the members of the Committee regarding CR-18-2016.

The Office of Law finds that CR-18-2016 is in proper legislative form and saw no legal impediments to its adoption.

The Office of Audits & Investigations found that enactment of CR-18-2016 will not have a negative or adverse fiscal impact on the County since it deals with federal funds.
