BILL

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Road Paving

3 For the purpose of providing a certain list of roads to be repaved to the County Council in
4 December on an annual basis; providing for the Department to present a certain list to the County
5 Council for general feedback; and generally regarding roads and road paving in the County.

6 BY repealing and reenacting with amendments:

7 SUBTITLE 23. ROADS AND SIDEWALKS.

8 Section 23-138,

9 The Prince George's County Code

10 (2023 Edition; 2024 Supplement).

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
12 Maryland, that Section 23-138 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same is hereby
13 repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:

14 SUBTITLE 23. ROADS AND SIDEWALKS.

15 DIVISION 3. DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION STANDARDS.

16 **Sec. 23-138. Standard paving sections.**

17 The Director of Public Works and Transportation shall establish minimum standards for
18 paving sections for each class of roadway and incorporate such standards into the Design and
19 Construction Standards. Where determined by the Director of Public Works and Transportation
20 to be necessary by reason of engineering criteria, special designs may be allowed or required.

1 [The Department of Public Works and Transportation shall submit to the County Council the list
2 of roads to be repaved at least 60 days before contracts are approved. The County Council, by
3 resolution, shall approve the list of roads to be repaved prior to the Department approving
4 contracts.]

5 The Department of Public Works and Transportation shall submit to the County Council for
6 review the list of roads to be repaved on an annual basis. The repaving list shall be prepared in
7 December, and the Department shall present it to the County Council for general feedback.

8 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the provisions of this Act are hereby
9 declared to be severable; and, in the event that any section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph,
10 sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of
11 competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the remaining
12 words, phrases, clauses, sentences, subparagraphs, paragraphs, subsections, or sections of this
13 Act, since the same would have been enacted without the incorporation in this Act of any such
14 invalid or unconstitutional word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, subparagraph, subsection,
15 or section.

16 SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45)
17 calendar days after it becomes law.
