## RESOLUTION

## A RESOLUTION concerning

United Communities Against Poverty

For the purpose of affirming United Communities Against Poverty (UCAP) as the Community Action Agency (CAA) for Prince George's County, supporting the restructuring of the Board of Directors, setting a period of time for reevaluation of the CAA and establishing certain evaluation criteria.

WHEREAS, in 1978, United Communities Against Poverty (UCAP) was designated as the Community Action Agency for Prince George's County by the enactment of Section 2-398 of the County Code; and

WHEREAS, in order to receive Federal and State funding Community Action Agencies must maintain a fully functioning Board of Directors which meets regularly; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of UCAP has restructured the membership of the Board to include 15 members, 5 of which are representatives of the County Government; and

WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Council supports the reduced size of the Board of Directors for UCAP; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Prince George's County Council to reevaluate the status of UCAP as the Community Action Agency for Prince George's County one year from the signing of this resolution; and

WHEREAS, the basic evaluation criteria will be type, cost and availability of services, financial viability, identification of new funding sources and development of partnerships with other social outreach agencies; and

WHEREAS, 4 of the 5 County Government representatives shall be appointed by the

County Council with periodic reporting requirements to the Council via a CAA Liaison.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's

County, Maryland, that the 4 County Council representatives on the Board will be designated as

one from the Northern area, one from the Southern area and 2 from the Central area of the

County, which is currently the area with the highest concentration of people receiving service

from UCAP.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Northern area includes Councilmanic Districts 1,

2, and 3; the Southern area Districts 4, 8 and 9; and the Central area Districts 5, 6 and 7; and that

the Council Members from each of these areas bear responsibility for jointly selecting their

Board representation.
