RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION concerning

State of Maryland Community Investment Tax Credit Program

For the purpose of approving the project submitted by Legal Aid Bureau, Inc. to the Maryland

Department of Housing and Community Development for participation in the Department's

Community Investment Tax Credit Program.

WHEREAS, Section 6-401 through Section 6-406 of the Housing and Community Development Article, Annotated Code of Maryland, established the Neighborhood and Community Assistance Program to assist nonprofit organizations in carrying out approved projects in designated revitalization areas, to encourage businesses to invest in priority funding areas, and to strengthen public-private partnerships; and

WHEREAS, Section 6-404 of the Housing and Community Development Article, Annotated Code of Maryland, provides for the allocation of tax credits to business entities that contribute to approved projects of nonprofit organizations that provide services to priority funding areas; and

WHEREAS, Section 6-405(c) of the Housing and Community Development Article, Annotated Code of Maryland, provides that the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development may not approve a proposal for participation in the Neighborhood and Community Assistance Program unless the proposal is approved by the governing body of the county that includes any of the Priority Funding Area that benefits from the project; and

WHEREAS, Legal Aid Bureau, Inc., a nonprofit organization, proposes to undertake the Housing Crisis Legal Assistance Project (the "Project") to provide free legal assistance to low-income individuals who are at-risk of losing their affordable housing due to eviction or

foreclosure and to expand services currently provided by the Legal Aid Bureau, Inc. to at-risk residents in furtherance of foreclosure prevention and the mitigation of economic distress related to foreclosure and eviction actions; and

WHEREAS, Legal Aid Bureau, Inc. has applied to the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development for approval of the Project and an allocation of tax credits in the amount of \$50,000.00 for business entities and individuals that contribute to the Project pursuant to the Department's Community Investment Tax Credit Program; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive expresses approval of the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, hereby expresses approval of the Project, as set forth in Attachment A, submitted by Legal Aid Bureau, Inc. to the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development for participation in the Community Investment Tax Credit Program.

APPLICANT:

Legal Aid Bureau, Inc. ("Legal Aid") is a private, non-profit law firm and the largest provider of civil legal services to the poor in the State by a substantial margin. Legal Aid's Metropolitan Maryland office in Prince George's County is located at 6811 Kenilworth Ave., Suite 500, Riverdale, MD 20737. Legal Aid has twelve other office locations throughout the State and has been providing high-quality civil legal services to Maryland's most vulnerable citizens for over 100 years.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Through this project, Legal Aid will provide free legal assistance to low-income residents who are at-risk of losing their affordable housing due to eviction or foreclosure in Baltimore City, Prince George's and Montgomery counties in targeted Priority Funding Areas. Revenue generated by Legal Aid's participation in the CITC program will provide funding for additional staffing and operational support. The project will expand services currently provided by Legal Aid to at-risk residents in these jurisdictions in furtherance of foreclosure prevention and the mitigation of economic distress related to foreclosure and eviction actions.

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FINANCIAL AND LOCAL CONTRIBUTION:

Legal Aid receives financial support from multiple Prince George's County sources. Legal Aid receives \$63,840 annually from a continuing Prince George's County Title IIIB grant and received \$10,610 of contributions from Prince George's County residents during its most recent fiscal year - 2011.
