**REPORT:** Committee Vote: Favorable 5-0 (Council Members Watson, Dernoga, Oriadha, Hawkins, and Harrison)

The Prince George's County Council's Government Operations and Fiscal Policy Committee convened on March 13, 2025, to consider **CR-012-2025**, a resolution concerning **Adjustments to Approved Position Grades**. The positions that would be impacted by this legislation reside in the Office of Human Rights, the Department of Family Services, and the Office of the State's Attorney.

Section 815(b) of the Charter for Prince George's County, Maryland, authorizes the Council, upon recommendation of the County Executive, by resolution, to make additional amendments to the number of Limited-Term Grant-Funded (LTGF) positions in each grade for a particular agency that were not included in the budget for the current fiscal year.

**The Office of Human Rights** is requesting one new LTGF position to support the Human Rights Commissioners.

**The Department of Family Services** is requesting ten new LTGF positions to support the Disability Apprenticeship Program. This is a technical adjustment, as these are existing positions that have transitioned from temporary/seasonal status to LTGF positions in FY 2025.

The Office of the State's Attorney is requesting two new LTGF positions to support prosecutorial operations.

The Budget and Policy Analysis Division notes the changes are all for LTGF costs that will be absorbed.

Ms. Terry Bell, representing the Office of Law, noted that the legislation had been reviewed and found to have no legal impediments to enactment.

Ms. Sakinda Skinner, County Council Liaison with the County Executive's Office, requested the committee's support.

After further discussion, the Government Operations and Fiscal Policy Committee voted favorably 5-0.
