HEALTH, EDUCATION AND HUMAN SERVICES COMMITTEE

Committee Vote: Favorable, 3-0 (In favor: Council Members Turner, Exum and Harrison)

Staff summarized the purpose of CB-96-2010 and informed the committee of written referral comments that were received. The bill amends the County Code modifying the composition and membership of the Youth Commission. The Commission will have one or more Advisors, to include the founder, to serve as ex officio members of the Commission.

The sponsor of CB-96-2010 provided correspondence from the Chatham County Youth Commission expressing their opinion of having the founder remaining actively involved to offer insight and to ensure that the activities of the organization continue to be consistent with the vision of the founder.

The Office of Law finds CB-96-2010 to be in proper legislative form and the Office of Audits and Investigations determined that enactment of CB-96-2010 will not have a negative fiscal impact on the County.
