The Fire/Emergency Medical Services Department's regulations are contained in Subtitle 11, the Fire Safety Code. This Code has not been updated in over 10 years. This extensive update includes provisions for inspections fees that mirror the State Fire Code, smoke alarm requirements that have already been implemented throughout the County, and water supply requirements for the rural areas of the County with no municipal water supply.
