RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 Specifications and Standards

3 For the purpose of amending the "General Specifications and Standards for Highway and Street
4 Construction" and the "Specifications and Standards for Highway Traffic Signals" of the
5 Department of Public Works and Transportation.

6 WHEREAS, Section 6 of the Schedule of Legislation of the Charter states that the Director
7 of Public Works and Transportation “shall administer construction and maintenance of all public
8 works, which shall include but not be limited to roads, streets, stormwater facilities, and bridges,
9 and such other functions as may be required by law;” and

10 WHEREAS, Section 23-128 of the County Code provides that amendments and revisions to
11 the "General Specifications and Standards for Highway and Street Construction" and the
12 "Specifications and Standards for Highway Traffic Signals" (collectively, “Specifications”) of
13 the Department of Public Works and Transportation shall be made by Council resolution; and

14 WHEREAS, the Director is proposing amendments to the Specifications, as set forth in the
15 Department of Public Works and Transportation, “Specifications and Standards for Roadways
16 and Bridges” (2007), a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's
18 County, Maryland, that the Specifications, as set forth in the Department of Public Works and
19 Transportation, “Specifications and Standards for Roadways and Bridges” (2007), be and the
20 same are hereby approved.
