RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 Exempt Employees in the Police Department

3 For the purpose of establishing certain exempt positions in the Police Department.

4 WHEREAS, Section 902 of the Charter of Prince George's County, Maryland enumerates
5 the County positions that are in the Exempt Service; and

6 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 902 (13) of the Charter of Prince George's County,
7 Maryland, the County Council, upon recommendation of the County Executive, may, approve
8 other positions to be in the Exempt Service; and

9 WHEREAS, the County Executive has determined it necessary to establish certain exempt
10 positions in the Police Department in order to achieve its operational mission.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's
12 County, Maryland, that the following positions shall be in the Exempt Services:

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland,
18 that these positions are entitled to and subject to the same retirement and pension benefits as are
19 provided by the County Personnel Law or other law to classified service employees of the
20 County.
