SECTION	1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,		
Maryland, that S	Section 2-497 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same is hereby		
repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:			
SUBTITLE 2. ADMINISTRATION.			
DIVISION 39. YOUTH COMMISSION.			
Sec. 2-497. Con	nmission composition; term; officers.		
(a) The Co	ommission shall be composed of up to thirty-seven (37) youth members. Youth		
members shall b	e selected on recommendation of the principal of each public and private high		
school in the County, and two (2) members may be children participating in the County's home			
school program	under the supervision of the Prince George's County Public Schools Department		
of Curriculum a	nd Instruction. Each member shall be a youth between the ages of fifteen (15)		
and eighteen (18) who has a sincere interest in and motivation to work for the community and

have a background of community-based activity. The Commission may also include the student member of the Prince George's County Board of Education as an ex officio member.

- (b) The term of office for each member shall be two years, with a maximum term of four (4) years for each member. Any vacancy shall be filled for the unexpired term in the manner of the original appointment.
- (c) The Commission members shall elect annually from their own membership a chairperson and such other officers as it deems necessary.
- (d) The Commission shall have one or more Advisors to serve as ex officio members of Commission providing guidance and encouraging the Commission to realize their full potential and attain the Commission's objectives as defined in Division 39 of this subtitle.

SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that Marilynn M. Bland, who formulated the framework for the creation of the Commission, remained actively engaged in the work and service of the Commission and the being one of the sitting Council Members favorably supporting CB-19-2006, an Act establishing the Youth Commission, shall serve as an Advisor to the Commission.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the provisions of this Act are hereby declared to be severable; and, in the event that any section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the remaining words, phrases, clauses, sentences, subparagraphs, paragraphs, subsections, or sections of this Act, since the same would have been enacted without the incorporation in this Act of any such invalid or unconstitutional word, phrase, clause, sentence, subparagraph, subsection, or section.
