WHEREAS, a follow up study by the Government Accountability Office (GAO) found that			
from 2016 through 2018, estimated rates of Severe Maternal Morbidity (SMM) among non-			
Hispanic Black and non-Hispanic American Indian/Alaska Native women were significantly			
higher than the e	stimate	d rate of SMM among non-Hispanic White women; and	
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's			
County, Maryland, that subject to appropriations, through budget allocation or funds raised			
through public or private partnerships, this Council will request that up to One Million Dollars			
(\$1,000,000.00) be allocated to the funding of a program titled "Black Maternal Health Fund"			
that is focused on black maternal health with grant awards given to non-profits that provide			
maternal health s	services	3.	
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the allocation of this funding to the Black Maternal			

Health Fund shall be overseen by the Prince George's County Council.
