RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION concerning

A Priority Preservation Area (PPA) Functional Master Plan for Prince George's County For the purpose of initiating a Priority Preservation Area (PPA) Functional Master Plan and approving Goals, Concepts, Guidelines and a Public Participation Program in order to satisfy the requirements of HB 2 2006, Section 3.05(a)(6)(ii)(8) of Article 66B in accordance with Section 2-518 of the Agricultural Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland that all Maryland counties intending to have a certified agricultural land preservation program prepare and adopt a Priority Preservation Area Element (PPA) in their comprehensive plans.

WHEREAS, Section 27-641 of the Zoning Ordinance establishes procedures whereby the Prince George's County Planning Board may initiate a functional master plan with the approval of the District Council; and

WHEREAS, the Approved FY 2010 Planning Department Work Program required the preparation of a Priority Preservation Area Functional Master Plan as a strategy to achieve certification of the agricultural preservation program and to satisfy the goals, policies and guidelines relating to the Rural Tier from the 2002 Prince George's County Approved General Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Goals, Concepts, Guidelines, and Public Participation Program (Attachment A) establish the purposes, the issues to be addressed during the plan preparation, and the methodology for ensuring adequate community involvement in the planning process; and

WHEREAS, on June 17, 2010, the Prince George's County Planning Board of The Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission, pursuant to Section 27-641 of the

Zoning Ordinance of Prince George's County, requested the Prince George's County Council to initiate the Priority Preservation Area Functional Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, on July 30, 2002, the Prince George's County Council, sitting as the District Council, approved the 2002 Prince George's County Approved General Plan in CR-47-2002.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Prince George's County, Maryland, that The Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission is hereby directed to prepare a Priority Preservation Area Functional Master Plan for Prince George's County, in accordance with Part 13 of the Zoning Ordinance.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that District Council has considered and hereby approves the Goals, Concepts, Guidelines and Public Participation Program, attached hereto as Attachment A and hereby incorporated as if fully expressed herein.
