REPORT: Committee Vote: Favorable, 10-0 (Council Members Ivey, Dernoga, Allen, Adams-Stafford, Fisher, Hunter, Olson, Oriadha, Burroughs, and Blegay)

The Prince George's County Council convened as the Committee of the Whole on March 3, 2026 to consider CR-009-2026, a resolution concerning the Accounting of Ice Detainees in Prince George's County for the purpose of reaffirming the County Council's commitment to the protection of civil rights and civil liberties for all people; and directing that the County partner with a local non-profit entity develop a roster of all residents of the County in potential Immigration and Customs Enforcement ("ICE") custody.

During the meeting, council staff provided an overview of the resolution, which would direct the County to partner with a local non-profit entity to develop a roster of all County residents believed to be in Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) custody. Funding for the partnership would come from the Non-Departmental section of the County budget.

The adoption of CR-009-2026 should not have a fiscal impact, as it is a transfer of appropriations for previously approved recreation programming and partnerships to a council-directed pilot program.

Council Member Fisher, the bill sponsor, stated that this bill will assist the County in tracking individuals taken into custody by ICE. The nonprofits envisioned for this work have unique capabilities in some cases that will allow them to track individuals in ways that police may not be able.

After further discussion, a motion was made by Council Member Blegay, and a second was offered by Council Member Hunter. The Prince George's County Council, sitting as the Committee of the Whole, voted favorably 10-0.
