## **BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:**

Pursuant to Chapter 594 of the 2005 Laws of Maryland, the Public Safety and Behavioral surcharge is required to be adjusted each fiscal year for inflation pursuant to the Consumer Price for All Urban Consumers (CPI-U). The CPI-U for April 2025 increased by 2.3% and results surcharge increase of \$74 above the Fiscal Year 2025 surcharge of \$3,229 for permits issued inside Developed Tier and inside an area included in a certain basic plan or conceptual site plan. The pro-

increase in the CPI-U results in a surcharge increase of \$223 above the Fiscal Year 2025 public surcharge of \$9,680 for permits issued for all other buildings.

For Fiscal Year 2026, the Public Safety and Behavioral Health surcharge shall be \$3,303 for p issued for construction located inside the Transportation Service Area 1, as defined by the Mary National Capital Park and Planning Commission in the Prince George's County Approved General and for construction in an area included in a basic plan or conceptual site plan that abuts an exist planned mass transit rail station site operated by the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Author Maryland Transit Administration and complies with the requirements of any sector plan, master p overlay zone approved by the Prince George's County District Council. The Public Safet Behavioral Health for Fiscal Year 2026 shall be \$9,903 for all other buildings.
