PUBLIC SAFETY & FISCAL MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE REPORT Date: 3/7/96

Committee Vote: Favorable as amended, 3-0. (In favor: Council Members Estep, Bailey and Del Giudice.)

This bill will amend the Code and transfer the permit responsibilities to the Gaming Permit Review Board.

The amendments are:

1. On page 2, line 21, insert "a new permit under Section 5-118.04"

The Office of Management and Budget stated that there will be some administrative costs associated with the Gaming Permit Review Board, even though the Commissioners of the Board will service without compensation.

There should not be any negative fiscal impact on the County as a result of the enacting CB-9-1996.
