**RESOLUTION**

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 Contract Approval

3 For the purpose of approving a multi-year contract to procure Claims Administration  
4 Services for Prince George’s County, Maryland on behalf of the Prince George’s County Office  
5 of Finance/Risk Management Unit

6 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 819 of the Charter for Prince George’s County, Maryland  
7 the County Council must approve, by resolution, all multi-year contracts exceeding an aggregate  
8 of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00); and

9 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 819 of the Charter for Prince George’s County, Maryland,  
10 no agency of the County government shall, during any fiscal year, expend any money or incur  
11 any liability in excess of the amounts appropriated and no such payment shall be made nor any  
12 obligation or liability incurred, except for purchases in an amount to be fixed by legislative act;  
13 and

14 WHEREAS, the County desires to enter into a contract with Sedgwick Claims Management  
15 Services, Inc. (Sedgwick); and

16 WHEREAS, the contract between Prince George’s County, Maryland and Sedgwick will be  
17 conducted pursuant to the terms and conditions contained herein as Attachments A and B.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's  
19 County, Maryland, that the agreement as described in Attachments A and B and pursuant to 819  
20 of the Prince George’s County Charter be and the same is hereby APPROVED.

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Executive is hereby authorized to make  
22 any modification, adjustment, corrections, or any other changes as may be necessary to finalize

1 the contract in any manner the County Executive may deem necessary or proper, but not altering  
2 its substance.

3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall become effective as of the date of  
4 its adoption.
