BILL

AN ACT concerning

The Classification Plan for Prince George's County

FOR the purpose of adding new classes of work.

WHEREAS, the County Executive, pursuant to Section 903 of

the Prince George's Charter and Section 16-125(a) of Subtitle 16 of the Prince George's County Code, has, in order to provide better governmental services, recommended to the County Council amendments to the Classification Plan for Prince George's County with respect to certain classes of work described within Section 1 of this bill;

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the Classification Plan for Prince George's County be and the same is hereby amended as follows:

3315M Paramedic IV, M-31
(\$36,670 - \$60,964)

3403B Emergency Dispatcher IV, B-21
(\$30,018 - \$47,904)

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45) calendar days after it becomes law.
