RESOLUTION NUMBER 2117

A Resolution of the Council of the City of Greenbelt to Establish School Zones on Municipal Roads in the City to Implement an Automated Stop Sign Enforcement Program Within the Established School Zones

WHEREAS, pursuant to §5-202 of the Local Government Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland, the City Council of the City of Greenbelt has the authority to pass such ordinances as necessary to protect the health, health, comfort, and convenience of the citizens of the municipality and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Greenbelt desires to implement a Stop Sign Automated Enforcement Program in the City of Greenbelt; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Maryland law, the automated system may only be enforced in school zones established in the City; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Md. Code Ann. Transportation §21-803.1, the City Council wish to establish school zones within a half (1/2) mile radius around certain City schools.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Greenbelt that, subject to compliance with all the applicable provisions of § 21-803.1 of the Transportation Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland, including the placement of appropriate signs in accordance with state law, school zones are established on all public roads with the City of Greenbelt that are within a half-mile radius of the following schools:

- 1. Eleanor Roosevelt High School
- 2. Greenbelt Middle School
- 3. Greenbelt Elementary School
- 4. Springhill Lake Elementary School
- 5. Dora Kennedy School

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage.
